The First View Security, Digital Door Viewer™ (DDV) is an innovative product designed to replace peephole door viewers with an electronic video system delivering on-demand, high quality images.

The DDV provides an expanded field of view from a comfortable viewing distance.

The Digital Door Viewer is quick and easy to install into new construction or retrofitted to existing doors and requires no connection to external power wiring or external monitor displays.



The monitor provides a large, clear view. Simply press the button to see...



Front of camera on the outside of your door is less than 1 inch in diameter and extends out less than 1/16 inch. Callers cannot see anything inside.

The 5.6 inch LCD monitor mounts on the inside of the door and provides a large, clear view. The high resolution color camera is mounted into the door and delivers a clear image in all lighting levels and even works through screen and glass storm doors.

By simply pressing a button, a live video image of the entire area outside of the door is displayed on the monitor. The DDV installs in just a few minutes using a standard power drill. It operates on 8 standard "AA" size batteries. The battery life is approximately 1000, 5 second viewing cycles. In typical operation, the batteries last for one year. Monitor 5 1/2" H x 8 1/2" W x 1" D.
